## This funding will be used to

- Raise student attendance to >94%
- Improve student learning outcomes to be at or above our National ICSEA rating (67<sup>th</sup> percentile) in all areas

## Our initiatives include

- Utilising the IMPACT model to unpack NLSC Pedagogical Framework
- Development of high performance Teaching and Learning teams – Heads of Department and Deputy Principals
- Establishing a NLSC coaching model to support and build teaching capability across the College P-12

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Resourcing and monitoring student attendance and engagement – including year level coordinator release and administrative support	\$73 000
• Resourcing the tracking and monitoring of student progress	\$48 587
• Continuing the position of Head of Department – Inclusive Education P-12	\$115 000
• Continuing the additional Head of Department – Senior Schooling Pathways position	\$115 000
• Development of College leaders through appointment of a lead coach – Deputy Principal Coaching and Capability Building	\$130 000
• Continuing the development and implementation of a Whole of College coaching model to enhance pedagogical practices P-12. Three coaches allocated across the four phases of learning	\$270 000
• Streamlining College operations for students, staff and community through the creation of the Deputy Principal College Operations position	\$130 000
