• Appointing an additional Head of Department – Senior Schooling Pathways	\$115 000
• Introducing a Head of Department – Junior Secondary	\$115 000
• Introducing a Whole of College coaching model to enhance pedagogical practices P-12	\$300 000
• Establishing a Deputy Principal – Achievement and Differentiation P-12	\$130 000
