- Targetted teacher aide support in Primary year levels to enhance reading outcomes and early intervention in formative years
- Development of Collegewide approach to Pedagogy
- Reviewing the alignment of P-10 curriculum to ensure validity , reliability and accessibility of assessment

• Enhance Student Engagement in Learning	\$40,000
• Implementing 8 House Leaders 7-12	\$48,000
• Continuing Head of Department – Inclusive Education P-12	\$137,000
• Continuing Head of Department – Junior Secondary	\$137,000
• Continuing Deputy Principal – College Operations (P-12)	\$156,000
• Professional Learning eg Writers Tool Kit, Brown Collective	\$103,483
• Support for student wellbeing programs	\$50,104
